

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

1. The semiotic meaning of the characterizations can be found in The SpongeBob Movie: Sponge on the Run. As in the movie, 64 data were found: 10 from SpongeBob, 9 from Patrick, 8 from Mr. Krabs, 8 from Squidward, 6 from Plankton, 6 from Sandy, 4 from Gary, 7 from King Poseidon, 4 from Sage, and 2 from Otto.
2. The realization of the characterizations in SpongeBob Movie: Sponge on the Run is realized through the way characterizations conveyed by each character. The characterizations is conveyed through different actions and through different language, which is referred to as verbal and nonverbal communication.
3. The reason the characters are used in this film is found in the animators' explanations by an interview in cited ScreenRant about the personality or characteristics of each character.

B. Suggestions

In relation to conclusions, suggestion are staged as the following:

1. This research can be used as a reference to enrich knowledge about semiotics, especially in analyzing characterizations in movies.

2. The findings of this research are suggested to movie audiences to help them understand the characterizations in movie and help them to know more about character in the movie.
3. It is suggested for the next research to explore semiotic characterization and the messages conveyed in other films, and the writer hopes this research could be used as a reference.
