CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

Based on the data and discussion of this research, the following conclusions may be reached. Regarding the first goal of this study, which was to identify and explain the types of words that are considered taboo in the *Army of The Dead* movie script, the study found that there are eight types of words that are considered taboo in this movie script: cursing, profanity, obscenity, vulgarity, slang, epithets, insults and slurs, and scatology.

Obscenity is the type of taboo word with the highest frequency. In 103 data, obscenity appears 33 times. Scatology has the lowest frequency, appearing just 2 times out of 103 data. Obscenity is always used in speech because it is thought to be the best way to express one's emotions and to insult and scream about something that makes one upset about their current situation. Additionally, it can easily harm another person's self-esteem and inclination or be used in an obscene manner to demonstrate contempt for them.

The least used taboo words are Scatology. Thus they are not a strong strategy to convey opinions or to show a piece towards people as they are simply dirty words. Using Jay's theory, the second objective of this study is to find out why the *Army of the Dead* movie script used taboo words. Jay says that there are five motives people use words that are considered taboo: anger and frustration, descriptive evaluative, joking, surprise, and sarcastic irony or insult. Additionally, this movie's script contains every motive. In the Army of the Dead movie script, the most common motive is anger and frustration, which is used 39 times, followed by joking 19 times, surprise 17 times, descriptive evaluative 16 times, and sarcastic irony or insults 12 times.

Anger and frustration show up commonly in this movie since it can satisfy the speaker's motivation of standing out from the crowd. Also, it could be the best capacity to make others center and grasp the speaker. Furthermore, the last reason for this study is to find the types and motives of taboo words in Army of the Dead movie script. Consequently, this study gave data in figuring out the use of taboo words particularly in the types and motives of taboo words. Taboo words are classified as horrible language and it will influence the audience with a particular goal in mind, however not all taboo words have a similar significance, it ought to be taken apart in light of the sentence plan to grasp the particular importance.

B. Suggestions

The researcher offered some suggestions for the meeting that would follow the completion of the study.

a. For students, because not each and every taboo word fits neatly into one of each type, the most important thing for students to understand is how to order the types and motifs of taboo words. This is due to the fact that not all taboo words can be categorized as one of each type. Depending on the sentence's arrangement, they can be cross-organized. b. For other researchers, this study focuses on the various types of taboo words and illustrates the motives or the reasons behind taboo words for other researchers with similar topics. There are numerous issues that require investigation. It could provide more data on comparable subjects and better agreement.
