CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

There are two sections to this chapter: suggestions and conclusions. Firstly, a summary of the research findings from this study is included in the conclusion. Second, readers—students or futher researchers are the target audience for this suggestion.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing the Hate speech comment on Truman Black Instagram
Post as the main data in this study, researchers found the following conclusions;

- Instagram comment section with the percentage order from the most dominant type to the least type found is as follows; behavior (59%), sexual orientation (13%), class (11%), disability (5%), race (4%), religion (4%), physical (3%), and ethnicity (1%).
- 2) Hate speech in the comment section also has motives that can be categorized from the most dominant to the least motive, namely; Sadism (35%), Revenge (18%), Power (19%), Ideology (21%), and Instrumental Violence (7%).

5.2 Suggestion

The researcher acknowledged that this study still had flaws owing to restrictions. As a result, the researcher made the following recommendations to the readers in order to take a pragmatic approach to hate speech.

- 1) The researcher expects that this research may present readers with many opinions linked to this object of study, especially related to the hate speech issues.
- 2) Linguistics and literature students are encouraged to utilize this study as a reference for doing future hate speech research using a pragmatic or other linguistic methodologies, such as semantic, sociolinguistic, and so on.
