This research deals with the students' types of intrinsic and extrinsic motivation in learning English. This research uses a descriptive qualitative method which aims to describe, explain and answer in more detail the research problems. The data is collected by distributing a questionnaire consisting of 14 statements to 18 students at grade X of SMAS Amir Hamzah Medan. The analysis found that: 1) Students have 3 types of intrinsic motivation, namely interest (69.5%), enjoyment (64%), and inherent satisfaction (75%); 2) Students have 4 types of extrinsic motivation, namely external regulation (69%), introjection regulation (53%), identification (72%), and integration regulation (78%). The results of this research will be useful for students to increase their intrinsic and extrinsic motivation in learning English.
