

## ABSTRACT

This research was carried out with the aim of determining the influence of the use of *multimedia-based* learning media on student learning outcomes in learning Indonesian of the Procedural Text material in grade V of SD Negeri 158469 Rawa Makmur, T.A. 2024/2025. The type of research used in this study uses *Pre-Experimental* using *One Group Pretest-Posttest Design*. The population in this study is all class V students totaling 20 students, 13 male students and 7 female students. The sample in this study is the entire population where all students are the subject of the study. The data collection used is using interviews, tests and documentation. The tool used in data collection is in the form of an objective test of 25 questions. The data analysis technique in this study uses the T-test. The results of the study were obtained: 1) The average learning outcome of the *Pretest* was 64.6 and the learning outcome of the *Posttest* was 74.8. 2) The data is normally distributed with the value of the *pretest* data  $L_{cal} < L_{tabel}$  which is  $0.171 < 0.190$  and the *posttest* data value of  $0.188 < 0.190$ , this shows that the two groups of data are normally distributed. 3) And from the results of the hypothesis tester it shows that the value of  $T_{count} > T_{table} = 4.132 > 1.729$  according to the criteria of the t-test if the  $T_{count}$  is greater than  $T_{table}$ , then  $H_0$  is rejected and  $H_a$  is accepted with the understanding that there is an influence The use of multimedia-based learning media on student learning outcomes in learning Indonesian of procedural text material in grade V of SD Negeri 158469 Rawa Makmur, T.A. 2024/2025.
