

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGESTIONS

After collecting the data and analyzing the result of the research. The researcher drew some conclusions and suggestions in the implementation Project Based Learning.

A. Conclusions

Based on this analysis, the conclusions that can be drawn are as follows:

1. The challenges faced by students in learning narrative text using Project Based Learning are taking a long time, requires money, memorizing dialog using English, making expressions according to the dialog and managing cohesiveness between groups. The factors that become obstacles are; students lack vocabulary, students are confused to understand the content of the text because they do not know the meaning of the text, students have difficulty in expressing the story.
2. The implementation of Project Based Learning in Narrative text can help to increase students' creativity. Narrative learning using Project Based Learning is still effective in class XI SMAN 1 Pancur Batu. Maybe there are still many challenges faced by students and teachers in the Implementation of Project Based Learning but students and teachers have followed the procedure well. So that students can explore their own knowledge.

B. Suggestions

In connection with these conclusions, the suggestions given are as follows:

2. Students are expected to practice the Implementation of Project Based Learning consistently and correctly to achieve their goals. In addition, students should also increase their vocabulary to make it easier for students to write something and be able to speak in English well and correctly.
