

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. CONCLUSION

After the researcher describe the analysis of figurative language used in Ava Max's song lyrics of *Heaven and Hell* Album, it is concluded that:

1. According to the first objective of this research which is to identify the types of figurative language, the researcher reveals that there are eight types of figurative language occurred in Ava Max's song lyrics of *Heaven and Hell* Album, namely Hyperbole, Metaphor, Simile, Personification, Metonymy, Litotes, Irony, and Oxymoron. It can be seen that the total of lyrics that contained figurative language from the data were 94 lyrics. The dominant types that used in Ava Max's song lyrics of *Heaven and Hell* was metaphor because in this contains more comparison sentences.
2. Based on the second objective of this research which is to analyze the realization of figurative language, the researcher reveals that there are eight types of figurative language used in Ava Max's song lyrics of *Heaven and Hell* Album, they were: (1) Hyperbole to exaggerate something more than fact, (2) Metaphor to compares two things that are not similar without uses word 'like' or 'as', (3) Simile to compares two different things uses word 'like' or 'as', (4) Personification to giving human ability to object, animal or

abstract ideas, (5) Metonymy to express a word or thought in a different way by using a closely related word or thought, (6) Litotes to emphasize the positive statement by using a double negative sentence, (7) Irony to describe contradictory sentence that are far from reality, and (8) Oxymoron to create emphasis uses two contradictory word with contradictory meaning.

3. The last object of this research is to explain the reason for the use of figurative language. Figurative language found in Ava Max's song lyrics of *Heaven and Hell* were used to give imaginative pleasure, additional imagery, emotional intensity, and means of concentration.

B. SUGGESTIONS

After conducting this research, then the researcher proposes a few suggestions as follows:

1. For the English Literature's students, the writer suggests to expand deeply the analysis of Figurative Language especially that occurred in daily activities such as from song lyrics.
2. For the future researcher, this research provides information in comparing the types of figurative language. This research can be helpful to get more references in finding out about figurative language. The future researcher are expected to analyze other topic about figurative language by using different object and theories.
