

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

#### **A. Conclusion**

After investigating the data, the researcher concluded that, There were three the types of satire is used in The Simpsons animated sitcom “sorry not sorry”. There were Horatian satire, Juvenalian satire and Menippean satire. Namely Horatian satire there were 7 sentences, Juvenalian satire there were 11 sentences and Menippean satire there were 4 sentences. Based on the analysis, the researcher found how The Simpsons used satire in the “sorry not sorry”. The Simpsons used satire in many ways. From used irony, parody, comparison and humor to criticize and satirize on something. The satire delivering from many ways, utterance, billboard, signboard, banner and advertisement.
