

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter provided two parts which are conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion explained about the summary of the findings and discussion obtained along the analysis of data process. Then, the suggestion is presented for the learners in English Literature and the further researchers.

A. Conclusion

After the researcher describe the analysis of satire in *The Daily Show* Twitter account, in this section the reseacher can concluded as follows:

1. In accordance to the first objective of this research which is to identify the types of satire, the researcher reveals that there are three types of satire occured in *The Daily Show* Twitter account, namely Horatian, Juvenalian, and Manippean. Horatian satire typically associated with humor and light moking at the same time. While, Juvenalian satire is quite bitter and angry, often used to express frustration or anger about a current state. In addition, Manippean satire commonly deal with mental attitudes of certain individuals rather than societal norms. It showed that each satire have their own distinct qualities, or even vary in levels of harshness.
2. Regarding to the second objective of this study which is to describe the realization of satire, the researcher reveals that there are seven

satirical techniques used in *The Daily Show* Twitter account, they were irony, paradox, antithesis, enlargement, anticlimax, exaggeration, and parody. Through the use of these techniques, the researcher can extra layer of meaning to satirical representation.

3. The final objective of this research is to explain the reason for the use of satire. Satire found in *The Daily Show* tweets were used to criticize some aspect of politicians or political groups by combining the critical statement and humor in order to create awareness of current issues and effect change.

B. Suggestion

After conducting this research, then the researcher would give some suggestion for others proposed as follows:

1. For the learners of English Literature, to comprehend the types of satire, the context and background knowledge are needed in order to understand how the satirist expressed satire and what is the satirical message understood from the text. Satire frequently contains references to current events or societal elements, so the audience must be familiar with the subject matter in order to truly get the point.
2. For the further researcher, this research provides information in distinguishing the types of satire, they could use some theories from this research to conduct another research about satire. There is also a possibility of another Twitter account which has different dominant

of satire. Besides satire does not obnly exist on Twitter, the further researcher are expected to analyse other topic about satire by considering different object and theories in order to discover various result.
